# & Safety Night

Johnnycake Corners Elementary School PTO will be hosting our first Trunk or Treat and Safety Night Family Fun Event in the JCES parking lot on Thursday, October 22, 2009 from 7:00-8:30 pm. Parents please have students wear school approved costumes\* and don't forget to bring a bag to hold their Trunk or Treat goodies.

\*Costumes should be of the non-violent/non-gory type and all weapon accessories should be left at home.

## Trunk or Treat and Safety Night Events

**From 7:00-7:30pm:** Representatives from Delaware County Sheriff's Department and the Sunbury Fire Department will be on hand with important safety information and will be giving demonstrations and tours of a sheriff's patrol car and fire truck!

**From 7:30-8:00pm:** Lt. Vogel of the Delaware County Sheriff's Department will be giving a presentation in the Commons area about stranger danger, candy safety, and the importance of using the buddy system while trick or treating.



**From 8:00-8:30pm:** To close out the evening, students will have a chance to go Trunk or Treating in the JCES bus drop-off parking lot. The JCES PTO and other volunteers will be passing out candy, treats, and lemonade to the students.

## Parking and Safety

Please park in the main JCES parking lot. Signs will be posted to direct traffic to the appropriate parking area. ONLY volunteers who will be passing out candy during the Trunk or Treat will be allowed to park in bus drop off parking lot. To help ensure safety and allow emergency access, overflow parking will ONLY be allowed along the right hand (West) side of Falling Meadows Drive (NO parking on both sides of the street).

Please...drive SLOWLY and watch for students when entering and exiting the event!
